Be careful with a sales pitch claiming to make an easy money!

Some international students unintentionally assist in crimes after having been offered "a job to make an easy money". Pay attention to the following cases in order to avoid getting involved in criminal conducts.

Stay on alert for phishing e-mails!!

There are increasing cases involving malicious e-mails and short messages in an attempt to guide you to phishing websites where you are asked to enter your personal information such as your residential address and credit card number.

Those mails are often disguised as credit card companies or financial institutions.


Don't access to the link address appeared on phishing e-mails/short messages and never enter your personal information.

STOP BUYING OR GIVING AWAY BANK ACCOUNTS AND CELL PHONES

- O You must not sell or give away your bank accounts and cell phones. You must not buy bank accounts and cell phones under someone eles' name.

STOP! WITHDRAWING DEFRAUDED MONEY

- O Never withdraw cash or make remittance using a card under someone else's name.

STOP! UNLAWFUL PACKAGE FORWARDING





Do I get that much money just reshipping a package from home? A package is sent to your home.

All you have to do is to forward the package to the address I instruct.

3,000 Yen per package

You will get paid in electronic money.

I see.
